Dear Parents:

We would like to announce that the registration for this year's Bay Area Fall Young Peoples' Conference is now open for sign up. The conference is for those young people who are in grades 7-12. For this conference, we will be concluding our fellowship on the book of Exodus and covering the subject of "Experiencing Christ for the Building of God". Please find below a summary of the key conference and registration details:

- Dates: October 21-23
- Location: Alliance Redwoods Conference Grounds in Occidental, CA
- Cost: \$120 per person, paid to your locality
- Registration Deadline: October 9

In addition, there are two other pages for you to review with your child. The first page includes the conference rules and regulations. The conference rules and regulations have been put in place so that we can have a sanctified time to enjoy and receive God's dispensing. Please encourage your child to acknowledge and comply with these rules and regulations. The second page is a Bible reading schedule to help prepare your child for the subject of the conference. We are encouraging all young people to spend time to read this before the start of the conference.

The first meeting of the conference will begin Friday evening, October 21 at 7:30 PM. We ask that you cooperate as much as possible to see that your child is ready to depart for the conference at a time that will permit timely arrival for the first meeting. Since the trip is a long one, you may need to pack a dinner or provide your child with money for a meal on the way to the camp.

If you should need to contact your child in the event of an emergency, you can call the camp office at (707) 874-3507 and dial "0" for the switchboard operator.

The weather may be cool so clothing should include a warm jacket for the evenings and mornings, sturdy shoes for possibly wet conditions, and additional changes of clothing.

Please pray with us that the Lord will use this conference to continue to lay a solid foundation in our young people and raise them up as our next generation.

## **Young People's Conference Rules and Regulations**

**The conference is a special time for us to seek after the Lord. To help us do so, we have the following rules and regulations. By following them, we will be able to turn our heart to the Lord, to pursue him without distraction, and to be alert and open to Him in every meeting.**

- 1) No electronic games or other equipment such as cell phones, DVD players, computers, video games, etc., are permitted, except for laptops for homework purposes only. Any such equipment, if discovered, will be held by the conference staff until we return home.
- 2) Dress should be appropriate and modest. Please avoid wearing clothing that have logos or other insignias, and are not befitting our stance as believers in Christ.
- 3) All meetings, including cabin times and corporate meetings must be attended.
- 4) Lights out times should be honored and no one is allowed to rise earlier than the designated time in order to assure that everyone gets the rest they need.
- 5) A rest period following Saturday afternoon's recreation time is mandatory.
- 6) Bring your Bible, hymnal, and notebook to all conference meetings and fellowship times.
- 7) Only foods provided by the camp or the conference itself are permitted during the conference. Snacks for the trip up are an exception.
- 8) Cabins should be kept in a neat and orderly condition at all times during the conference.
- 9) Serving ones should be respected and obeyed. Disobedience or disrespect shown is grounds for dismissal from the conference and prohibition from future conferences.
- 10) The camp staff and their guests should be respected. Disobedience or disrespect show will also be grounds for dismissal from the conference and prohibition from future conferences.
- 11) Problems with the facilities (light bulbs, heater malfunctions, etc.) should be directed to the serving ones or conference coordinators, not directly to the camp staff.
- 12) No changes in cabin assignments are permitted without the permission of both serving ones involved, and all changes made must be reported immediately to the camp registration booth the first night.
- 13) Your failure to comply with the rules of the conference will be grounds for dismissal.
